



Sewell, NJ - The Rowan University Ice Hockey team continued its unbeaten record in The Great Northeast Collegiate Hockey Conference action this past weekend, extending its conference record to 3-0 by beating Franklin and Marshall by a score of 13-2.

In the first period, Rowan came out flat while Franklin and Marshall came out flying, outracing Rowan to pucks, and winning most of the one-on-one battles, but at the end of one period, the score was tied 1-1, compliments of Ryan Simrell goal on a nice feed from Charlie Drass.

Having weathered the first period F and M storm, Rowan pumped up their legs and showed their speed and skill in the second period. About six minutes into the period, Chris Keyser opened the Rowan barrage on a nice two-on-one feed from Joe Abate. Rowan scored the next five goals in quick succession: Fred Brewer on a nice touch pass from Mike Keating, Colin Davis on a stuff rebound of a Cameron Rowand shot, Lanny Frederick on a one-timer in front of the net from a behind-the-net feed from Ryan Schureman, Bill Choy unassisted on a beautiful, two player walk around from the right circle, and Fred Brewer again on a nice cross-ice feed from Anthony Ciccotelli. Rowan outshot F and M 19 to 4 for the period.

Rowan continued the barrage in the final period, scoring six more times. Fred Brewer scored on a glove-side snap shot after a Bill Choy feed, followed by unassisted goals by Cameron Rowand, Joe Byrne, Fred Brewer, Joe Abate and Dan Urbaniak. For the game Rowan outshot F and M 48 to 27. Rowan goaltender Nick DiPaolo made several spectacular saves enroute to stopping 25 out of 27 shots. DiPaolo upped his Conference record to 2 wins, no losses.

This weekend, Rowan plays two away games. Rowan faces The College of New Jersey at Loucks Arena, on campus of Lawrenceville Prep School, on Friday night at 8:00 pm. On Saturday, Rowan faces Seton Hall at South Mountain Arena at 8:15 pm.
