Season Outlook: Finishing last season ranked 14th in the Southeast Division with a 12-14-2 overall record, the Profs struggled early in the season after a very successful 2007-2008 campaign. The Profs managed a good stretch in the middle of the season that saw them go 7-1-2 and had them headed for post season play however after some injuries and a short bench, the Profs struggled to finish .500. Key moments during the season saw the Profs loosing to Wagner with two minutes remaining and shutting out Temple in one of the best games of the year.

Entering the 2009-10 campaign, Rowan returns a balanced core of players that should help the team fight for playoff and divisional contention. Despite losing key seniors, the Profs roster remains solid with returning players including last season's leading point scorer Colin Davis and top forward Fred Brewer, who is returning from an injury plagued season.

"We have been building this program for the last three years to make it one of the premier in the region. Our goal, as always, is to make it to the playoffs and beyond. While simultaneously building a tradition that focuses on consistency and pride every year," head coach John Caulfield said. "We have a lot of impact players returning, and some promising young guys coming in, with all of us like minded we will make this program an elite place to play."

Rowan will welcome few key freshmen to the roster this season that will help balance the roster to the level they saw during their 2008-2009 season when they brought in a solid line that included Davis that helped them win the championship.

"We only graduated four seniors last season," associate head coach Mike Husek said. "That leaves us with a lot of options for next year with the type of freshman class we are expecting. A few of the returning players will have to challenge to play on a nightly basis but I think everyone will make positive contributions."

Returning between the pipes will be Brian Pacek who has been the centerpiece for the Brown and Gold during the last two seasons. A late addition of Brien Bennett last season should hopefully see a good Rowan duo in the crease. Alex Wooley and Rob DeSimone will anchor a solid defensive corps.

Since Caulfield took over at the helm in 2006, the Profs have made strides in becoming one of the most prestigious programs in the region. This season looks to be no different.

The Profs appear to be well prepared and with some good additions should be in position to make another run for the league championship.
